ABOUT THE DISTRICT

The Cherry Creek Vista Park & Recreation District owns and maintains six tennis courts, a swimming pool, four parks, and four playgrounds. The District also maintains 2.6 miles of county right-of-ways along Havana and Orchard streets and 2.6 miles of brick fence.

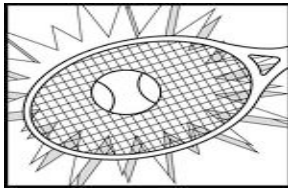

Here are just a few of our class offerings:

4-5 years old Gorillas Beginner

These classes are designed to get our future players started out right. The instructors will teach and refine throwing, catching and movement skills necessary as the foundation to play tennis in the future.

5-6 years old Baseline Bullies Beginner

Stepping up from our Gorillas class, these classes continue to build on the skills necessary for match play and introduce beginning racquet skills.

6-7 years old Future Stars Intermediate

These classes are for 6-7 year olds who want to move into match play. Each class will include not only two days each week of practice, but also weekly inter- and intra-club match play. Using a modified court and balls, our Future Stars' will learn to serve, rally and score all on their own.

7-10 years old Mid-court Monsters Beginner

Lots of tennis games and fun without the pressure of competition, and commitment. Great for beginners and those kids who just want to enjoy some organized play and exercise.

8-9 years old Brawlers Intermediate

These classes are for 8-9 year olds who want to move into match play. Each class will include

not only two days each week of practice, but also weekly inter- and intra-club match play.

10-18 years old Junior Tennis League Beginner/Intermediate

The Rocky Mountain Junior Tennis League is an inter-club only league for 8-18 year olds. Matches are played against other RMTA clubs in the South-East Denver area. Youths are grouped by age and ability and RMTA staff is present at all matches. No need to create a team.

8-18 years old USTA Jr. Team Tennis

Beginner/Intermediate/Advanced
The USTA Junior Team Tennis program is a national program run for 8-18 year olds which culminates in the top teams in each division playing for local, state and national championships. Teams will be formed by parent captains.

Adult Beginner

This class designed for beginner adults is the perfect opportunity to learn to play tennis, develop your skills and meet other players.

Adult Ladies Drill and Play

Please call ahead at 303-482-1002; keys may be picked-up during regular business hours.

Courts are designed for tennis only. Skateboards, bicycles, rollerblades, pets, etc. are not allowed on the tennis courts. Please be courteous and keep use to one hour per court when others are waiting.
